

### ***Instructions to the Northwestern Lake***

Head east out of Portland along Highway 84 to exit #64 in Hood River. If you are coming from the other direction, still look for exit 64. Turn left (or right) at the exit and cross the Hood River Bridge to the Washington side (.75 cents to cross). At the stop sign at the end of the bridge, turn left onto Highway 14.

Go 1.4 miles and turn right on Highway 141 towards Trout Lake. Proceed to stop sign. Turn left towards Trout Lake. At approximately 3.8 miles you will see a yellow road sign indicating a road intersecting from the left. Slow down, turn your left turn signal on and watch for the Northwestern Lake sign on the right. It is brown with yellow lettering and is difficult to see. Be prepared to turn left at the sign onto Northwestern Lake Road.
